

COMMON HOMEOWNER QUESTIONS & ANSWERS.

1. How will the Sentricon® System protect my home?

It eliminates the termite colony. The Sentricon System not only provides continuous protection from termites — even against those that have not yet moved onto your property — but it also eliminates termite colonies. The proof is in 30 independent university studies and 45 published scientific articles, plus millions of homes. The Sentricon System even protects the White House, the Statue of Liberty and other national landmarks.

2. How is the Sentricon System with Always Active technology different?

The bait stays in all the Sentricon stations all the time. With Always Active™ technology, we put new Recruit® HD termite bait in all the Sentricon stations from the very beginning, so termites can begin feeding on it as soon as they find a station. This starts the colony elimination process sooner and keeps property protection continuous.

3. How do termites find the Sentricon stations?

Worker termites are constantly foraging for new food sources, even if there is an ample supply present. The Sentricon® System with Always Active™ technology is designed so that the Sentricon stations intercept the random foraging patterns of the workers. They ingest the Recruit HD termite bait they find in the Sentricon stations and carry it back to the colony.

4. Does the Sentricon System attract termites?

No. The Sentricon System takes advantage of termites' natural foraging behavior, so they will find the Sentricon stations. The bait in the Sentricon System is an insect growth regulator. The termites will feed on the Recruit® HD bait, take it back to the colony, and feed their nest mates. The termites will start dying off, but they will not be able to pinpoint where the active ingredient is coming from. So, the entire colony will be eliminated.

5. Is it okay for my kids and pets to play near the Sentricon stations?

Yes. Although Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations do not permit any product registered by the agency to control pests to be called "non toxic", it is good to know that the active ingredient in Recruit HD termite bait, noviflumuron, controls termites by disrupting a molting process that occurs only in insects and closely-related organisms. Additionally, the bait is housed in a child/pet resistant station preventing easy access by anyone other than the service technician.

6. What will happen to my pets if they come in contact with the Sentricon stations?

The active ingredient, noviflumuron, is an insect growth regulator. The label indicates it has extremely low toxicity to mammals as the relevant enzyme system affected is not present in mammals. Noviflumuron is not absorbed by mammalian tissue.
